

FREE QUILTING CLASSES

Saturday:

10 am: Antique sewing machine repair – fundamental techniques of machine repair. Restore your grandmother's old treadle and use it! Feel free to bring your machine to the park and we'll work on them during the session.

1:30 pm: Beginning quilting. Learn the fundamentals of designing quilt tops, using the newer tools (such as rotary cutters and mats) and get a free pattern to design your own quilt top. Fabric can be purchased on-site, or if you would rather purchase your fabric elsewhere, the requirements are:

1 yard print #1

1 yard print #2

1 yard print #3

1 yard color/solid/semi-solid print to coordinate with #1

1 yard color/solid/semi-solid print to coordinate with #2

1 yard color/solid/semi-solid print to coordinate with #3

2.5 yards muslin, bleached or unbleached

This will make a full sized quilt top.

10 am: Crafty sewing – projects for gifts & the home. We will cover some simple things that make great wedding, birthday, anniversary or Christmas gifts that can be given from your hands and heart. Fabrics can be purchased on-site, or bring some fat quarters to yard-sized pieces.
